CRITERIA FOR AWARD

- The recipient should be any community member or group who has made a significant contribution to the Brockton Public Schools through volunteerism.
- The community member or group should have been involved in a Brockton Public School program or another program in the school for at least two years.
- Any member of the Brockton community can make a nomination for the award (i.e. principal, teacher, parent, community member, organization, or other BPS staff member).
- The recommendation should highlight the service performed by the nominated community member or group.

The Executive Committee shall make the recommendation to the Community Schools Advisory Board from all the submitted nominees.
